## Wines by the glass

### *Sparkling*

'19 La Maschera Prosecco - SA - \$15

### *Blanc*

'19 Twin Island Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, NZ - \$15

*It has an intense aroma combining citrus peel, passionfruit and fresh garden herb notes. The palate shows grapefruit and papaya flavours with hints of bell pepper*

'19 La Vieille Ferme Grenache Blanc - Rhone Valley, FR - \$15

*Pretty Pale-yellow dress. This wine reveals an elegant nose with delicate notes of white flowers and citrus. This lively wine is very fresh and has a touch of minerality on the palate.*

### *Rouge*

'18 Palliser Estate Pencarrow Pinot Noir – Martinborough, NZ - \$15

*The nose exhibits wild strawberry, cherry and spice aromas*

'19 La Vieille Ferme grenache/Syrah - Rhone Valley, FR - \$15

*From the world-famous Chateau de Beaucastel, this medium-bodied, Southern Rhone red is packed with juicy red berry fruits and savoury complexity. Finishing dry, it's a winner with grilled meats.*

Piano De Cerro syrah - Akerenza, IT - \$25

*An alluringly sweet scent reminiscent of balsamic vinegar and honey with notes of ripe dark fruits and warming spices. Notes Black currants, blue berry, black berry, earthy spices & touch of cocoa.*

## **French Red**

'12 Chateau St Georges Bordeaux - \$135

*This satellite appellation has turned out a very good 2012 St.-Georges offering notes of damp earth, forest floor, black cherries and black currants in its medium-bodied, spicy, masculine personality*

'14 Chateau Labegorce Margaux – Bordeaux \$140

*(Really expressive, with a gorgeous beam of raspberry, blackberry and blueberry fruit driving through, inlaid with graphite and anise notes. The very polished feel lets the fruit glisten on the finish.)*

'16 Chateau Mont Redon - Chateau neuf du Pape - Grenache Shiraz - \$148

*(The layering of flavours and depth of tannin is immense intense raspberry and black currant compote notes form the core, which is dense in feel, with melted liquorice, singed anise and warm fruitcake flavours filling in around the fruit.*

'17 St Joseph Rouge - Domaine Aurelien chatagnier – Syrah – Northern Rhone \$138

*(The wine is juicy and dark-fruited, marked by an impeccable balance. )*



# Wine Menu

## Champagne and Sparkling

**2018 La Maschera Prosecco**                      **South Eastern Australia**                      **\$ 47**

Aromas of green apple, lemon curd and subtle passion fruit. Hints of mojito cocktail and fresh herbs. Tangy flavours of green melon, white peppercorn and apple. Moreish acidity with a subtle creamy textured finish.

**Alasia Moscato**                                      **Piemonte, Italy**                                      **\$ 55**

Light gold in colour, powerful aromas of honey, flowers and fresh grapes. Intensely sweet palate with flavours of grapes and citrus and finishing cleanly with refreshing acidity.

**2016 Corte Giara Prosecco**                      **Veneto, Italy**                                      **\$ 59**

Characteristically dry, this complex sparkling wine has all the acidity that you want in a Prosecco, as well as a hint of coffee right at the end to keep things interesting.

**Veuve D'Argent Blanc de Blancs**                      **Burgundy, France**                                      **\$ 59**

Golden-tinted colour with delicate bubbles and a fine foam. Floral and nutty bouquet (hazelnut, almond). A lively and fresh attack. Round on the palate with honeyed aromas.

**Jansz Premium**    **Tasmania**    **\$ 65**

A lovely aperitif style, with lifted honeysuckle and citrus from the Chardonnay and delicate strawberry Pinot characters.

**Louis Bouillot Perle d'Ivoire**                      **Burgundy, France**                                      **\$ 75**  
**Blanc de Blancs**

The nose develops aromas of citrus and flowers, evolving to butter and brioche notes with age. The palate is round and intense, with very complex secondary aromas.

**Pol Roger NV**

**Epernay, France**

**\$ 121**

Contains approximately one third of each three grape varieties of Champagne. Pinot Noir contributes body, depth of character and life extending tannins, Pinot Meunier adds youthful freshness, vigour and plump fruit character while Chardonnay gives lightness, elegance and firmness.

Champagne with great finesse and rare elegance. Light, fruity and crisp.

## White Wine

<b>2018 Opawa Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>Marlborough, NZ</b>	<b>\$ 49</b>
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This wine is bright lemon colour with a hint of green. The palate is refreshing and intense, displaying ripe citrus, honeysuckle and passionfruit flavours, this wine is well balanced and focused with crisp acidity and a long, juicy, mouth-watering finish.

<b>2019 Twin Islands Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>Marlborough, NZ</b>	<b>\$ 47</b>
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It has an intense aroma combining citrus peel, passionfruit and fresh garden herb notes. The palate shows grapefruit and papaya flavours with hints of bell pepper and thyme which leads to a refreshing juicy finish.

<b>2020 Wirra Wirra Hiding Champion Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>Adelaide, SA</b>	<b>\$ 48</b>
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Passionfruit, gooseberry and freshly squeezed citrus dominate, followed by more subtle grassy, leafy notes and a touch of kaffir lime.

### **Réserve Côtes du Rhône Blanc**

<b>2019 Tomfoolery Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>Barossa Valley, SA</b>	<b>\$ 58</b>
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Generously aromatic with fresh peas and jasmine florals, and a zesty lime lift. Zippy lime and gooseberry fruit with intense minerality on a fresh, light palate, all tied together with crisp natural acidity on a clean, lingering finish.

<b>2018 Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Sav Blanc</b>	<b>Loire Valley, France</b>	<b>\$115</b>
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Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity is tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, dry, and youthful.

<b>2019 Jim Barry JB Riesling</b>	<b>Clare Valley, SA</b>	<b>\$ 45</b>
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Pale straw colour in the glass. The nose is vibrant with clean, fresh cut citrus and a hint of lime. Palate has lashings of flavour with a generous fruit salad of honeydew melon and lemon rind. The finish is classic, clean and moreish.

**2019 Mt Difficulty Bannockburn Pinot Gris 2019, NZ** **\$ 67**

Aromas of white peach and pear blossom mingled with underlying crisp red apple notes. Such a beautifully vibrant wine.

**2019 Brokenwood Hunter Semillon** **Hunter Valley, NSW** **\$ 65**

Wonderfully floral and fresh to start, showing expressive fruit and a grounded, minerally under-layer. The combination gives a light, gentle, crisp, dry white, featuring the distinctive citrus and lemongrass-like aromas and flavours of early picked Semillon.

**2018 Hugel Gentil** **Alsace, France** **\$ 62**

Grapes Pinot Gris, Riesling, Pinot Blanc. The bouquet is youthful and refreshing, spontaneously expressing an agreeable aroma of green apple, pear, lychee, passion fruit, rose and the lightest touch of Muscat.

**2015 Trimbach Riesling** **Alsace, France** **\$ 66**

Bright straw-yellow. Green apple, white flowers and a note of powdered stone on the nose and palate. Juicy, spicy and nicely delineated, finishing with lovely mineral tang and lemony acidity.

**2018 Forest Hill Highbury Chardonnay** **Mount Barker, WA** **\$ 45**

Bright straw colour. Aromas of pears, citrus and nougat with hints of flintiness. The palate has flavours of fresh citrus and figs and hints of nuttiness on a zesty finish.

**2018 William Fevre Petit Chablis Chardonnay** **Chablis, France** **\$ 75**

Fruity and floral characters, along with the regions typical mineral notes ensure it is light and lively on the palate.

**2016 Dalrymple Cave Block Chardonnay          Pipers River, TAS          \$79**

Delicate white floral notes initially lift out of the glass before the more noticeable aromas of ripe fresh cut nectarine combines with nougat, hazelnuts and mixed dried spices. Flavours of nectarine and citrus form the core of the fruit characters, with brioche and crushed nuts adding complexity and a sense of texture. The 2016 vintage has a generous finish, fine acidity and dry through the palate, giving life and focus to the fruit flavours.

**2016 Heggies Reserve Chardonnay          Eden Valley, SA          \$ 98**

Complex aromas of citrus curd, stone fruit and fresh figs with notes of struck flint, brioche and a hint of spicy French oak.

**2018 Dappled Chardonnay          Yarra Valley, VIC          \$ 75**

A mixture of white stone fruits and fragrant citrus flowers are combined with almond meal and fine flinty aromatics. The palate is rich and decadent like a baked apple pie; buttery, nutty, creamy.

**2016 Terre Du Lias Chardonnay          Arbois Pupillin, FR          \$ 98**

Great minerality, citrus, nuts and herbs, medium body. Smooth, velvety, rich and warm, with savory and fresh aromas.

**2017 Chateau-Fuisse Pouilly Fuisse          Burgundy, France          \$ 129**  
**Tete de Cru Chardonnay**

Golden apples, ripe pineapple, coconut and toasted almonds, transitioning to sensations of lemon cream and creme brûlée on the palate.

**2016 Saint Veran Chardonnay          Burgundy, FR          \$ 120**

Domaine Sophie Cinier. Lovely peach and honeysuckle nose, gently oaked it cossets the palate with toasty vanilla essence and it has a mild creamy texture to the peach and pineapple fruit, countered by a smooth lime citrus blade.

**2017 Chablis Premier Cru Les Vaillons          Burgundy, France          \$ 135**  
**Chardonnay**

Light, dry, with high acidity. Green gold in colour, almond and fresh butter nose, full and supple palate, this wine is the ladies' favourite.

Transparent, dark fruited but light and clean, succulent tannins, exceptional length and very fine in feel.	<b>Tasmania, TAS</b>	<b>\$ 59</b>
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<b>2019 Brokenwood Pinot Noir</b> Lifted red cherry over sweet earthy savoury characters with a touch of oak sweetness.	<b>Beechworth, VIC</b>	<b>\$ 72</b>
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<b>2018 Dalrymple Pinot Noir</b> Ripe dark cherry, strawberry and anise flavour profile underscored by subtlety toasted cedar and forest floor characters.	<b>Tasmania, AU</b>	<b>\$ 75</b>
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<b>2016 Philip Shaw No 8 Pinot Noir</b> Delicate ripe cherry and redcurrant, but smokiness, briar, sweet damp earth and roasted chestnut. The palate is fresh and perfectly taut, with a fresh orange acid crunch.	<b>Koomooloo Vineyard, NSW</b>	<b>\$ 120</b>
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<b>2016 Domaine Faiveley Mercurey</b> <b>Premier Cru "Le Clos Du Roy"</b> Deep ruby red in colour with notes of fresh red fruits and spice on the nose. This wine is a pleasure to drink thanks to its smooth, fruity attack and delicate, silky tannins.	<b>Burgundy, France</b>	<b>\$ 145</b>
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### **2016 Villacampa Roble Tempranillo**

**Ribera del Duero, Spain \$ 57**

Washed by the Duero River, Villacampa is located at the western most side of Castilla y León region, in the Valladolid and Zamora provinces. 90% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Classic and traditional wine made from Tempranillo 100%. Cherry red colour. Exquisitely fruity. On the nose, its rich aromas have a pronounced intensity with an initial scent of ripe red fruit followed by gentle sweet notes of vanilla and spices. Pleasantly tasty in its palate, structured and with good acidity.

## **Beaujolais**

### **2015 JJ Vincent Julienas Beaujolais Cru**

**Burgundy, France \$ 85**

Clean dark red ruby colour and a nice brilliance. Fresh fruity on the nose and characteristic flower aromas of peyoni and ripe red fruits (wild-strawberries, red-current and raspberries). Crisp with good intensity and length, soft and fine tannins

### **2015 Bernard Metrat Chiroubles**

**Burgundy, France \$ 75**

Rich cherry and red fruit aromas with a touch of aniseed and exotic spices. Full and deep palate backed by fine silky tannins

## **Merlot**

### **2013 Chapelle L'Isle Bordeaux Superieur**

**Bordeaux, France \$ 85**

Light and fruity. Nice taste of French oak and light cherry. Smooth chocolate aftertaste

### **2011 Domaine A Merlot**

**Tasmania, AU \$ 165**

There are hints of licorice, strawberries, the tannins are starting to melt and it's just beautiful and riveting. On the nose it exudes intense blackcherry, plum, forest berries and dark chocolate aromas.

## Shiraz

**2018 Langmeil Longmile Shiraz** **Barossa Valley, SA** **\$ 45**  
On the nose aroma of Satsuma plum and mulberry fruits, mingle with floral and herbal notes and hints of liquorice allsorts and white pepper.

**2018 Heathcote Shiraz** **Heathcote, VIC** **\$ 55**  
The palate is full of rich firm tannins with notes of strawberry, caramel and all-spice.

**2017 Jim Barry Lodge Hill Shiraz** **Clare Valley, SA** **\$ 52**  
Aromatics of red and black berry fruits, a lift of violet florals, clove spice and mixed garden herbs.

**2017 Yalumba Galway Shiraz** **Barossa Valley, SA** **\$ 55**  
Aromas of blood plum, Christmas pudding and five spice that speak of its varietal and regional origins. Ripe and generous, flavours of mulberries, mocha and hints of beetroot.

**2017 Vasse Felix Shiraz** **Margaret River, WA** **\$ 78**  
A great Margaret River Shiraz with temperate ripening conditions promoting fruit intensity, richness and fine tannins.

**2018 Ministry of Clouds Shiraz** **McLaren Vale, SA** **\$ 75**  
Full bodied, dense black colour, intense blackberry & liquorice aromas. Rich blackberry, blueberry, black berry flavours)

**2017 Oliver Taranga Shiraz** **McLaren Vale, SA** **\$ 90**  
Classic full-bodied Shiraz with rich chocolatey fruit and smooth, silky tannins.

**2015 Yalumba Octavius Shiraz** **Barossa Valley, SA** **\$ 284**  
Exhibits savoury notes of red currants followed by dried herb aromatics, leading into almost sweet and sour plums.



**2017 Famille Perrin Reserve** **Rhone Valley, France \$ 65**  
**Cotes du Rhone Rouge - Shiraz/Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre**

Deep ruby colour with an earthy nose; rich, smooth, and tangy, with blackberry and plum showing on a lush palate that gives way to a long finish.

**2018 Le Mas Domaine Clavel** **Domaine Clavel, France \$ 88**  
**70% Syrah, 30% Grenache**

Lovely floral black cherry nose with some peppery hints, and some wet stones. The palate is juicy and bright but has lovely depth of cherry fruit with a touch of meatiness and some gravelly grip. This wine is juicy, deep, finishing long.

**2016 Chateau Mont Redon** **Rhone Valley, France \$ 148**  
**Chateau Neuf du Pape Grenache Shiraz**

The layering of flavours and depth of tannin is immense intense raspberry and black currant compote notes form the core, which is dense in feel, with melted liquorice, singed anise and warm fruitcake flavours filling in around the fruit.

**2015 Yalumba The Signature** **Barossa Valley, VIC \$ 146**  
**Cabernet Shiraz**

Medium to full in body, there's a refined feel to the rich blackcurrant, liquorice and blackberry fruit which is intertwined with vanillin cedar, light earth and spice.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

**2018 Forest Hill Highbury** **Mount Barker, WA** **\$ 47**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Bouquet: Blackberries, Florals, Dark Chocolate - Palate: Fine Tannins, Rich, Blackcurrant

**2017 Wirra Wirra Church Block** **McLaren Vale** **\$ 56**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Rich red and black fruits fill the mouth. Raspberry, red currant and plum fruits are balanced with fine sandy tannins and cedar oak.

**2019 Tomfoolery Son of a Gun** **Barossa Valley, SA** **\$60**  
**Cabernet Shiraz**

Toasty, chocolatey, clovey blackberries. It's warm and round, with luxurious fruit.

**2018 Langmeil Blacksmith** **Barossa Valley, SA** **\$ 68**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Lifted blueberries, red currants and black olive dominate the aroma with biscuit, cedar, liquorice and hints of menthol adding to the complexity.

**2017 Vasse Felix Premiere** **Margaret River, WA** **\$ 97**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Mid bodied, mulberry and blackberry-fruited, with a peppering of cocoa and coffee grounds.

**2016 Wirra Wirra The Angelus** **McLaren Vale, SA** **\$ 134**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Dry, full bodied. The nose shows fragrant red and black currant, a forest-floor earthiness and briary, tobacco-leaf character.

## Syrah

**2017 Le Pigeolet Vin de Pays du Vaucluse      Rhone Valley      \$97**  
**Cabernet - Grenache - Syrah**

This has a brambly and wild array of red and dark berries, as well as plush red plum, cherry and raspberry fruits. Very vibrant. A terrific vintage of this wine.

**2017 Piano De Cerro Syrah      Acerenza, IT      \$ 115**

An alluringly sweet scent reminiscent of balsamic vinegar and honey with notes of ripe dark fruits and warming spices. Notes Black currants, blue berry, black berry, earthy spices & touch of cocoa.

**2015 Yalumba Tri Centenary Grenache      Barossa Valley, SA      \$141**  
The fresh, red-floral perfume and the raspberry and redcurrant aromas are so fresh.

**2015 Yalumba The Signature      Barossa Valley, VIC      \$ 146**  
**Cabernet Shiraz**

Medium to full in body, there's a refined feel to the rich blackcurrant, liquorice and blackberry fruit which is intertwined with vanillin cedar, light earth and spice.

**2017 St Joseph Rouge      Rhone, France      \$148**  
**Domaine Aurelien Chatagnier Syrah**

The wine is juicy and dark-fruited, marked by an impeccable balance.

**2014 Cornas Domaine Auguste Clape      Rhone Valley, France      \$355**  
**Syrah**

Brilliant purple. Powerful, mineral-tinged cherry and blackberry scents, along with notes of bacon fat, liquorice, potpourri and pungent flowers. Pure, concentrated

and energetic on the palate, offering deeply concentrated black and blue fruit flavours that gain weight and become sweeter with air. Closes extremely long, sappy and sweet, juicy acidity adding lift and cut to the blue-fruit-dominated, youthfully tannic finish.
