





2017 Le Pigeoulet Vin Cabernet - Gren	•	Rhone Valley	\$25

This has a brambly and wild array of red and dark berries, as well as plush red plum, cherry and raspberry fruits. Very vibrant. A terrific vintage of this wine.

Premium French Red

'12 Chateau St Georges Bordeaux - \$135

This satellite appellation has turned out a very good 2012 St.-Georges offering notes of damp earth, forest floor, black cherries and black, spicy, masculine personality. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, well balanced with crisp acidity, more black fruit emerging towards the finish accompanied by tobacco and cedar.

2009 Chateau Labegorce Margaux – Bordeaux \$165

Bordering one of the world's most famous vineyards this is a hidden gem which feels like a grand cru. Your typical Bordeaux blend being predominantly Cabernet sauvignon it carries length and complexity, from perfectly integrated oak comes amazing Hughes of dark chocolate and great herbal notes. Really expressive, with a gorgeous beam of raspberry, blackberry and blueberry fruit driving through, inlaid with graphite and anise notes. The very polished feel lets the fruit glisten on the finish.

'16 Chateau Mont Redon - Chateau neuf du Pape - Grenache Shiraz - \$148

A classic style from Chateau Neuf, it carries a lot of length, dark forest fruits with bright cherries, the wine is all about the tannin structure, which is your overall mouth feel. Leaving a luscious lasting integrated feel of balance and harmony between the fruit acid and structure.

'17 St Joseph Rouge - Domaine Aurelien chatagnier – Syrah – Northern Rhone \$138 (temp unavailable)

(The wine is juicy and dark-fruited, marked by an impeccable balance.)

2014 Cornas Domaine Auguste Clape Rhone Valley, France \$355 Syrah

Brilliant purple. Powerful, mineral-tinged cherry and blackberry scents, along with notes of bacon fat, liquorice, potpourri and pungent flowers. Pure, concentrated and energetic on the palate, offering deeply concentrated black and blue fruit flavours that gain weight and become sweeter with air. Closes extremely long,

sappy and sweet, juicy acidity adding lift and cut to the blue-fruit-dominated, youthfully tannic finish.

Premium Australian Red

2016 Domaine Faiveley Mercurey Burgundy, France Premier Cru "Le Clos Du Roy" Merlot

Deep ruby red in colour with notes of fresh red fruits and spice on the nose. This wine is a pleasure to drink thanks to its smooth, fruity attack and delicate, silky tannins.

2011 Domaine A Merlot Tasmania,

\$ 165

There are hints of liquorice, strawberries, the tannins are starting to melt and it's just beautiful and riveting. On the nose it exudes intense black cherry, plum, forest berries and dark chocolate aromas.

2015 Yalumba Octavius Shiraz

Exhibits savoury notes of red currants followed by dried herb aromatics, leading into almost sweet and sour plums.

Medium to full in body, there's a refined feel to the rich blackcurrant, liquorice and blackberry fruit which is intertwined with vanillin cedar, light earth and spice.

This wine presents with a deep ruby red colour that gives a hint to the intensity it has to offer. The aroma of black currants & dark cherries are complexed by subtle hints of rosemary & mint. 2018 Opawa Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, NZ

This wine is bright lemon colour with a hint of green. The palate is refreshing and intense, displaying ripe citrus, honeysuckle and passionfruit flavours, this wine is well balanced and focused with crisp acidity and a long, juicy, mouth-watering finish.

2019 Twin Islands Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, NZ

It has an intense aroma combining citrus peel, passionfruit and fresh garden herb notes. The palate shows grapefruit and papaya flavours with hints of bell pepper and thyme which leads to a refreshing juicy finish.

Passionfruit, gooseberry and freshly squeezed citrus dominate, followed by more subtle grassy, leafy notes and a touch of kaffir lime.

Mader is a boutique-quantity producer located in the village of Hunawihr, Alsace. Made from a blend of 2/3rds Auxerrois and 1/3rd Pinot Blanc with 8% of this wine aged in barrel this shows classic white flower and citric aromas leading to a crisp and refreshing palate.

2017 Clarence House Estate Pinot Blanc

Expansive citrus and pear on the palate, but with excellent focus and lift thanks to spice, mineral and tangy peppery **notes**. The flavours build and deepen into the finish, which is wonderfully fresh and quite long. Gooseberry aromas with depth and character without overt herbaceous character.

Réserve Côtes du Rhône Blanc

Rhone Valley, France

Subtle nose with subtle hints of white flowers, honeysuckle and sage. Round and supple in the mouth, this wine reveals beautiful minerality, freshness and a slight bitterness on the finish.

2019 Tomfoolery Sauvignon Blanc

Barossa Valley, SA

\$ 58

Generously aromatic with fresh peas and jasmine florals, and a zesty lime lift. Zippy lime and gooseberry fruit with intense minerality on a fresh, light palate, all tied together with crisp natural acidity on a clean, lingering finish.

2018 Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Say Blanc

Loire Valley, France

\$115

Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity is tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, dry, and youthful.

2019 Jim Barry JB Riesling

Clare Valley, SA

\$ 45

Pale straw colour in the glass. The nose is vibrant with clean, fresh cut citrus and a hint of lime. Palate has lashings of flavour with a generous fruit salad of honeydew melon and lemon rind. The finish is classic, clean and moreish.

2019 Mt Difficulty Bannockburn Pinot Gris 2019, NZ

Aromas of white peach and pear blossom mingled with underlying crisp red apple notes. Such a beautifully vibrant wine.

2019 Brokenwood Hunter Semillon

Hunter Valley, NSW

\$ 65

Wonderfully floral and fresh to start, showing expressive fruit and a grounded, minerally under-layer. The combination gives a light, gentle, crisp, dry white, featuring the distinctive citrus and lemongrass-like aromas and flavours of early picked Semillon.

2018 Hugel Gentil

Alsace, France

\$ 62

Grapes Pinot Gris, Riesling, Pinot Blanc. The bouquet is youthful and refreshing, spontaneously expressing an agreeable aroma of green apple, pear, lychee, passion fruit, rose and the lightest touch of Muscat.

A classic and one of the all-time greats.

The natural oils coming through entice anyone's gums, it has the kerosene that would be expected from any Riesling from Alsace with great minerals. Bright straw-yellow. Green apple, white flowers and a note of powdered stone on the nose and palate. Juicy, spicy and nicely delineated, finishing with lovely mineral tang and lemony acidity.

2016 Les Sorceries – Grenache Blanc Cotes de Roussillon, France \$ 65

This aromatic blend of Grenache Blanc, Vermentino (aka Rolle), Roussanne and Macabeu is a wonderfully refreshing, citrusy and camomile-scented mineral white with sufficient weight to partner fish or chicken.

2018 Forest Hill Highbury Chardonnay Mount Barker, WA \$ 45 Bright straw colour. Aromas of pears, citrus and nougat with hints of flintiness. The palate has flavours of fresh citrus and figs and hints of nuttiness on a zesty finish.

2018 William Fevre Petit Chablis Chardonnay Chablis, France \$ 85 Fruity and floral characters, along with the regions typical mineral notes ensure it is light and lively on the palate.

2016 Dalrymple Cave Block Chardonnay Pipers River, TAS \$79 The 2016 vintage has a generous finish, fine acidity and dry through the palate, giving life and focus to the fruit flavours.

2016 Heggies Reserve Chardonnay Eden Valley, SA \$ 98 Complex aromas of citrus curd, stone fruit and fresh figs with notes of struck flint, brioche and a hint of spicy French oak.

2018 Dappled Chardonnay

Yarra Valley, VIC

A mixture of white stone fruits and fragrant citrus flowers are combined with almond m eal and fine flinty aromatics. The palate is rich and decadent like a baked apple pie; buttery, nutty, creamy.

Classic and traditional wine made from Tempranillo 100%. Cherry red colour. Exquisitely fruity. On the nose, its rich aromas have a pronounced intensity with an initial scent of ripe red fruit followed by gentle sweet notes of vanilla and spices. Pleasantly tasty in its palate, structured and with good acidity.
